Workout Short Cuts?

Looking to get more from your work out without spending more time working out? I was reading about compression clothes and decided that maybe I could get more done in the same amount of time just by wearing a new type of workout clothes.

Compression clothes are made with bands of Spandex pulling across your body. They claim to help you work harder.

I decided to get a pair of compression shorts a try to see if they would help me get more out of my workout. I also wanted to test the proper care for compression clothes, so I had to sweat in them first.

Sherry went online and found some compression shorts and ordered my usual XL. As soon as I got the package, I tried them on. I was able to get them over my ankles but not much higher than my calves. So I sent them back and got the next size, a 2XL. I was able to get these over my knees, but my thighs wouldn't cooperate. I sent these back, swallowed my pride and ordered a 3XL.

I felt like a Bride-to-Be when she tries on her first wedding dress. They run a little small, I'm told.

The good news is that I raised my heart rate trying to squeeze, twist and pull my body in these 3XL compression pants

I finally pulled the compression shorts over my hips and headed to my Spin PILATES . CYCLING . BOOTCAMP Class at Core Fitness



in Cahaba Heights. They offer Spin, Pilates, Barre and other fitness classes. Their Spin class works my body like no other fitness regimen I've tried.

The thing about spinning is you control your speed and resistance and manage your heart rate up or down. I learned in just a few minutes that I had to cut my speed and resistance back because my heart rate was moving into the anaerobic zone much faster than usual because those shorts were pulling against EVERY **SINGLE MOVE** I made!

I couldn't get these shorts off soon enough - literally!

It was like taking a hike with a 60 lb. back

I ventured out another day for a long walk wearing those damn shorts. Again, my heart rate increased faster than normal. I realized that I didn't need hills to get my

heart rate in my working zone when I wore those shorts.

There are no shortcuts to an effective workout.

After my very un-scientific tests, I believe real athletes or just us regular folks can benefit from compression shorts if they push themselves and don't back down on the effort like I did. I suspect it would also be a good way for anyone to prepare for a long hike.

But what if you wore the shorts all day under your regular clothes?

You'll probably burn more calories if you move around like normal. You might be a little more worn out at the end of the day as well. But I haven't tested this theory for one real reason.

If you wear these tight-fitting shorts under your street clothes, don't wait until the last minute when nature calls. It takes just a little longer to get those shorts where they need to be.

"Did You Know Where This Saying Came From..."

If You Can't Stand The Heat, Get Out Of The Kitchen

Origin: It's thought that Harry S. Truman is the one who coined the phrase, and he used it as early as 1942. In The Red

For example, in the Daily Globe newspaper from the year 1927, under the subheading 'Failed to get Interest,' it reads: "I regret to report to you that the people who put money into it failed by \$30,000 to earn even operating expense and depreciation. The company is in the red all the time."

CARING FOR CLOTHES MADE WITH ELASTIC AND SPANDEX

A lot of clothing has Spandex, Lycra or Elastane and we all know that clothing made with these fabrics will stretch a bit.

Yoga pants are generally made from a blend of cotton, lycra spandex, nylon, polyester or wool (for those in Canada, I guess).

The compression pants I tested were made of nylon, spandex (over 30%) and polyester.

And there are many bathing suits made with Spandex.

Did you know Spandex is an anagram for "Expands?" And did you know that the City of Rockport, Massachusetts once banned yoga pants from being worn in pubic?

So how should you care for clothing made with these stretchy fabrics?

Avoid heat so always use cold water and tumble dry on low heat. Also avoid bleach and fabric softeners. These additives will cause elastic to degrade quickly.

You can also break Spandex fibers easily. So avoid sitting in your swim suit on rough surfaces, like the side of many swimming pools or wooden furniture at the pool.
