I believe Sammy Dunn's teams outworked most of the other teams around. He had good talent. But probably not overall any better than other kids in the Region and throughout the State. They were just better prepared with the fundamentals and dealing with the pressure of the moment during games.

Coach Dunn was successful on and off the field. His players loved him. They would do anything to please him. That's true leadership.

When we opened Champion Cleaners in

2002, Coach Dunn and his wife, Linda, came in for our open house the day before we opened. They even brought some clothes for us to clean. They were our second customer. Our computer system automatically assigns a customer number to all new customers. The Dunn's account was tagged with the number 2 (actually CH00002). The coincidence here is all three of our sons played at VHHS wearing jersey #2.

Sammy Dunn died in 2004 after a battle with cancer.



"Did You Know Where This Saying Came From..."

Banned In Boston



Meaning: An act, saying or verbiage that should be prohibited. "That was so bad, it should be banned in Boston."

Origin: a phrase employed from the late 19th century through the mid-20th century, to describe a literary work, song, motion picture, or play which had been prohibited from distribution or exhibition in Boston, Massachusetts. During this period, Boston officials had wide authority[how?] to ban works featuring "objectionable" content, and often banned works with sexual content or foul language. Early instances of works being "banned in Boston" extend back at least to the year 1651. That year, William Pynchon, the founder of Springfield, Massachusetts—Massachusetts' great settlement in the Connecticut River Valley—and the former treasurer of the Massachusetts Bay Colony, wrote a book criticizing Puritanism entitled, The Meritous Price of Our Redemption. Boston, founded by Puritans and, at that time, ruled as a de jure theocracy, banned Pynchon's book and pressed him to return to England. He did so in 1652, which nearly caused Springfield to align with the nearby Connecticut Colony.

Cold Turkey

Meaning: Quitting something abruptly.

Origin: "Cold Turkey" stems from the fact that a plate of cold turkey is a simple meal without many frills—that is, it was pretty plain. Therefore, "talking cold turkey" meant "talking plainly." That said, there isn't a lot of direct evidence to back this theory up either, but it's seemingly the most likely of the various theories etymologists have come up with.

HOW TO CLEAN A BASEBALL HAT

Baseball hats get a regular dose of sweat and dirt. Kids and a lot of Dads don't really care about that, but they should. Worn and ragged hats are in favor today, but dirty hats aren't.

HERE ARE STEPS FOR CLEANING BASEBALL HATS:

- 1. Thoroughly rinse the hat for a couple of minutes with clean water right in the sink. This will remove a lot of the surface dirt.
- 2. Spot clean areas using an old toothbrush with a mixture of mild dish soap or laundry detergent and clean water. Scrub the obvious stains with small circular motions.
- 3. Using dish soap or laundry detergent in the sink with fresh water, hand wash the entire hat. Swish it around in the soapy water for several minutes. The dirtier the hat, the longer the swishing. You may need to drain the dirty water and repeat the process if the hat is particularly dirty.
- 4.If you have a particularly bad stain, try using some diluted Oxiclean scrubbed onto the stain. But test Oxiclean in an inconspicuous are to make sure there is no color loss.
- 5. Allow the hat to dry but you need to provide support the hat so it will keep its shape. Sporting goods stores carry hat forms that are made for this. If you don't have one, fold up a towel or place it on a large can. A cantaloupe might be perfect as well.

I have also used the dishwasher with a hat form to clean a hat. But don't wash dirty dishes at the same time.
