### The Best Use of My Shoulder

I played little league baseball as a kid. My coach saw me as one of the big kids and coaches put the big kids behind the plate. But I loved it. I was attracted by all the equipment. I was involved in every pitch and I was the only one on the field that could see the entire field. I even talked a little trash to the batters. That was fun.

The downside to catching is you throw the ball a lot, even more than a pitcher. A pitcher doesn't throw every game. The catcher does.

After most games my shoulder ached. I wasn't a gifted thrower, so I always had to put a little extra effort into a throw just to look good.

Fast forward a couple of decades and I'm coaching my three sons in baseball. Most years I coached a team and helped with another – and I always had batting practice duties. Maybe I could throw batting practice better than the other Dads or maybe I just thought that I could. But it was my job. Every team - every year. During the season, I would throw maybe 300 pitches in a session. And then I'd move to the next son's team where I would throw another 300 pitches. My arm ached at the end of the day.

I remember clearly thinking back in the day that my right shoulder will give me trouble when I get older. Boy, was I was right!

Since early this year, the pain in my right shoulder got worse and the arthritis medicine wasn't hiding my problem as it had done for the previous ten years. So I saw an Orthopedic Surgeon and he quickly told me

that I got just about everything possible out of my right shoulder. Surgery was the only relief and since I also had rotator cuff problems, a reverse replacement technique was the recommendation. This is the specialty of Dr. David Adkison at St. Vincent's who handled my surgery.

For years I hadn't been able to screw in a light bulb above my head with my right hand. Putting on a belt had become a challenge. Lifting a drink and shaking hands were sometimes painful. I couldn't even sleep with my hands on my pillow or put my right arm around someone's shoulder for a hug without pain. Most anything requiring raising my arm or reaching around my back felt like my shoulder was being squeezed in a vice. I would see lightning bolts and my eyes would tear up.

It's amazing what you can learn to do with your non-dominant hand in order to avoid crying.

I scheduled the surgery for May 20 before the fire at our Greystone facility on April 15, so in the midst of working through the challenges of the fire, I had shoulder replacement surgery. Both were equally unpleasant. I needed medication for both but only had it for one

Now my shoulder is getting better every day. I'm not ready to throw a baseball yet, but I'm getting close. I don't know why I would want to throw a ball again.

During my recovery and the necessary painful



physical therapy, I kept reminding myself that I was having the surgery not to be able to throw a ball again but to relive the pain. I'll continue to screw in light bulb with my left arm. So what can I do now that I haven't been able to do for the last 10 years?

I have an answer to that question. I'll be able to lie next to Sherry as we go to sleep and let her place her head on my shoulder like a pillow with my arm around her and cuddle a little. It was our routine for the first 39 years of our marriage. But I've missed that simple pleasure for the last 10 years.

And that's the best use of my shoulder for the rest of my life!

### PIECE OF CAKE

### MIND YOUR P'S & Q'S

## REMOVING URINE FROM A MATTRESS

Accidents happen – but you don't have to live with the smell for long.

Here are 6 steps for removing the odor of urine in a mattress:

- Remove the bedding as soon as possible and wash it as usual.
- 2. Blot the stained area with paper towels or a terry cloth towel. Blot do not scrub and force the urine deeper into the mattress.
- 3. Mix equal parts of water and white vinegar. Using a spray bottle, spray the mixture all over the affected area.
- 4. Spread baking soda over the entire affected area. Let it sit for at least 8 hours.
- 5. Vacuum the excess baking soda.
- 6. If the smell remains, repeat the process

Don't rush it. It takes time but this process should get that mattress smelling fresh again.
